

To whom it may concern

Herewith we would like to confirm that silicon carbide (CAS N° 409-21-2, EC N° 206-991-8) produced by SiC Ma members has no classification and labeling requirements according to the Regulation (EC) N° 1272/2008 on Classification, Labelling and Packaging (CLP Regulation). The CLP Regulation is the implementation of the UN GHS in European legislation.

Following European legislation for Silicon Carbide a registration dossier has been submitted to and accepted by European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in 2010. For the preparation of the registration dossier several legally prescribed analytical tests have been performed by certified laboratories. Based on these scientific tests it was concluded that Silicon carbide does not fulfil the criteria of a hazardous substance according to CLP/GHS. Consequently no classification and labeling requirements exist for silicon carbide according to CLP/GHS. Silicon carbide from SiC Ma members complies with the substance specification of the tested material.
